How does it work?

Party hosts donate their time and money to host a party of your choice. WSFEE collects a per guest fee that is donated to the WSFEE grant fund. Party hosts are eligible for a reimbursed percentage of the party fees collected. The more money that is raised, the more you are reimbursed. WSFEE can help determine the price for each guest, promote your party, and manage the sign-up procedure at the WSFEE Dinner Dance on 2/11/11.

- Determine your budget and the maximum number of guests
- Pick a date and place (we are seeking party hosts for March 2012 through October 2013)
